



The Truth About Drinking – Presentation Description

(1.5 hours) – Grades 8-12

In this video presentation students learn what the future may hold if they continue to drink. See a CAT scan proof of the “shriveling” effects of alcohol on the brain and autopsy proof of liver damage in a young adult. Witness the effects of impairment on vision, coordination, and reaction time — even when not fully intoxicated. See the reality of binge drinking and alcohol poisoning; of teen alcoholism and rehabilitation struggles. Watch a realistic, emotional simulation of the tragic consequences of drunk driving. A powerful program incorporating multiple perspectives, including appropriate charges from the Criminal Code of Canada, and how much an Impaired Driving charge can cost you.
