







## Professional **Development**



The reality is that most teachers and school staff are dealing with more challenging behaviors in more challenging teaching circumstances than ever before. It is critical that all staff have a common language and feel confident in dealing with issues of bullying before they escalate in the classroom or on-line. While traditional problem-solving techniques have served well in our schools over the decades, the issue of bullying requires a much more systemic approach.




